About the Role:

- Track record of at least 1-3 years of work experience in a relevant field preferably with European institutions, EU clients, partners and organisations.
- Knowledge of EU Cohesion policy and in particular of ERDF is a plus.
- Experience in policy analysis and evaluation skills (linked to regional development, clean transition or other related fields such as Recovery and Resilience Facility, security, employment and social policy is a plus).
- Experience in Better Regulation evaluation (knowledge of Better Regulation guidelines and Toolbox is a plus).
- Experience of qualitative and quantitative research including designing, analysing and writing up findings from desk research, interviews, focus groups, surveys, and other data sets.
- Ability to work under pressure and on your own initiative, to manage multiple tasks and meet deadlines.

Desirable

- Experience in supporting business development activities, writing successful bids, reports and concept notes (strong desirable);
- Confidence and expertise in qualitative and/or quantitative research;
